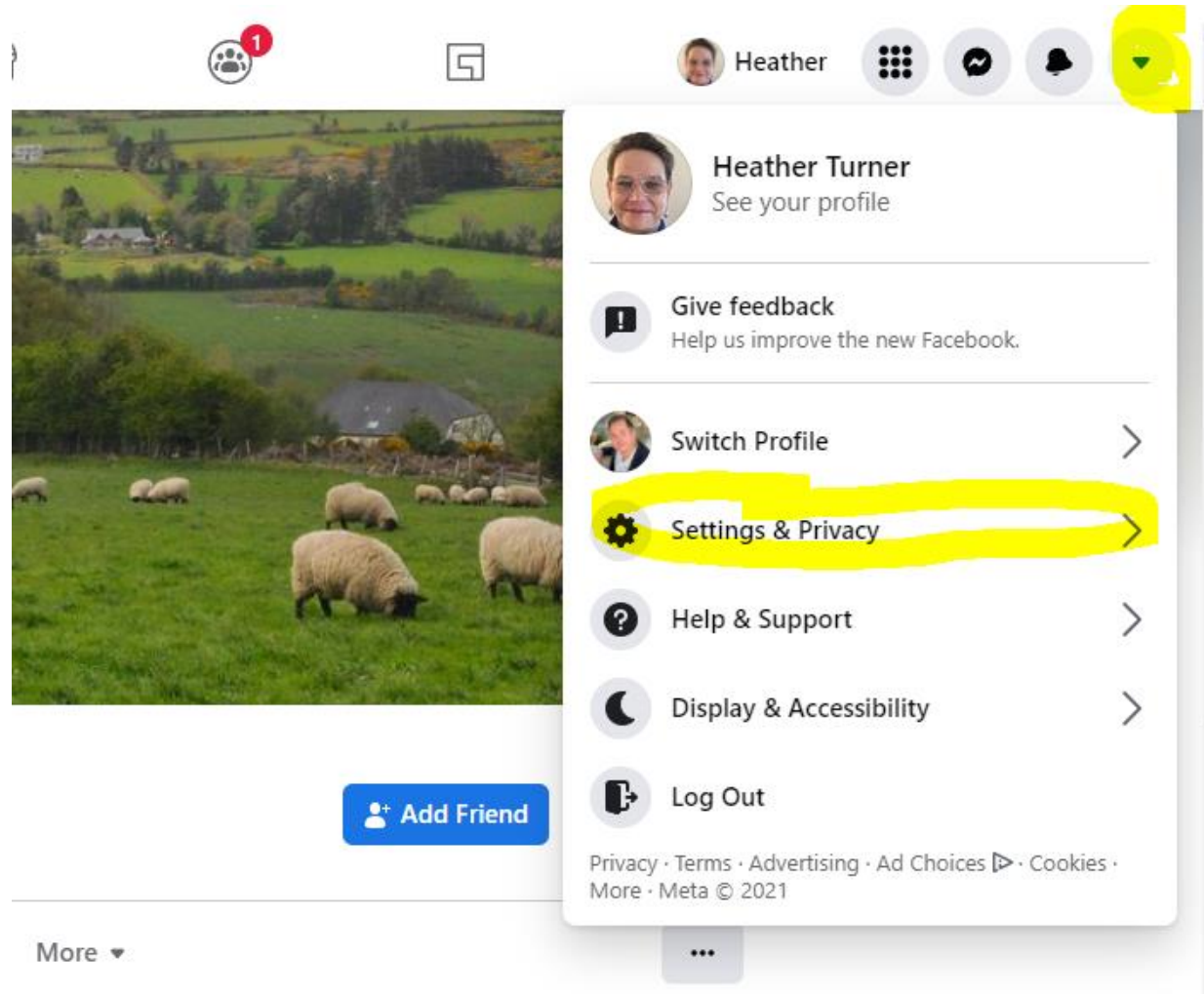



	Who can see your friends list? <small>Remember, your friends control who can see their friendships on their own Timelines. If people can see your friendship on another timeline, they'll be able to see it in News Feed, search and other places on Facebook. If you set this to Only me, only you will be able to see your full friends list on your timeline. Other people will see only mutual friends.</small>	Only me	<a href="#">Edit</a>
	Who can look you up using the email address you provided?	Only me	<a href="#">Edit</a>
	Who can look you up using the phone number you provided?	Only me	<a href="#">Edit</a>

To check what others see, ie you may want to change the exposure of some of your information and the privacy level of other posts as well

### Preferences

#### Apps, websites and games

Gives you the ability to use Facebook to log into and interact with third party apps, websites and games as well as connect accounts you have with other apps, websites and games to Facebook.

Turn Off

#### Game and app notifications

Allows notifications for game requests from friends, game status updates and app notifications from app developers on Facebook. Changing these settings will not affect games in your game settings or impact your ability to use apps or play games.

Turn Off

If you don't recognize the app or are unsure of the security or safety of the app, remove it.
